

This year, we've stepped up our awareness-raising activities with high-impact campaigns for causes close to our hearts, but also to inspire change on a daily basis, whether by reducing our carbon footprint, preserving our wild spaces or protecting the living world. We've also helped many animals in need. Those struck by fate, like the Moroccan earthquake in October, and also those hit by human mistreatment, like the abused animals rescued by YouCare.

From 2023, we will also keep in mind an important milestone for our Group: the inauguration of Equestrio Farm with numerous guests who got to attend the exclusive preview of the magnificent film BAKELITE which addresses the scourge of plastic pollution in our oceans. On land, trees are also at the mercy of human activity, and we had the immense honor of organizing a conference on this topic with the delegation of Chief Raoni, who is fighting to protect the Amazon rainforest.

Seeing the fruits of our support on the ground acts as a real catalyst for our motivation. The positive energy, the feeling that change is still possible, and the confirmation that each action counts... all of this is a veritable source of satisfaction for any philanthropist who is looking for concrete, immediate and visible results.

- 2. Raising awareness and fostering commitment to the causes we support.






Taking action with direct impact

Before deciding to support a project, we scrupulously study the association that supports it, how it functions, its members, its financial situation and long-term vision.





At the roots of Equestrio Foundation

Struck by the emergency of the environmental issues threatening our world of today and that of future generations, philanthropist and equestrian Alicia Heiniger decided in 2019 to create Equestrio Foundation in Geneva. A natural extension of her attachment to animals and her passion for photography, Equestrio Foundation is the concrete expression of a strong conviction: we can no longer just stand by and watch in silence as our biodiversity is being destroyed.

With Equestrio Foundation, Alicia Heiniger has elaborated a differentiating philanthropical strategy that structures our whole approach around two pillars: (1) the funding of human-scale projects that have a tangible impact and (2) awareness raising on these projects through video and photo reports that highlight the project leaders and strengthen awareness of environmental and animal well-being issues among the largest number.

This vision has rapidly been turned into a reality with the support of 35 projects since we began our activity on the ground in 2020.

Continuity and novelty

In 2023, we funded **ten local and international projects** in areas ranging from **wildlife conservation**, **defense of endangered species and animals in need**, to the **fight against plastic pollution** in our mountains and oceans. We also took emergency action to help animals hit by the Moroccan earthquake in September.

Our donations have been split evenly between organizations we worked with for the first year and existing partners. This allowed us to confirm with a larger number of partners the **relevance of our three-year support approach**. Through these long-term partnerships we are able to implement a **real impact strategy**, both by funding the projects on the ground and by raising awareness of the associations and the issues they fight for.

Strengthening our awareness-raising actions

Our goal is to maximize the impact of the causes we uphold. Equestrio Foundation supports medium-sized associations that do not necessarily have the means to raise public awareness about the importance of their causes. In addition to funding their projects, we have therefore continued to promote their actions among as many people as possible.

Raising awareness, educating, inspiring and mobilizing people to take action is a fundamental pillar of our strategy, which we have strengthened in 2023 through innovative and differentiated formats. To this end, we have created a full-time Communications Manager position to coordinate and produce these communication campaigns.

In 2023, we allocated 80 376 CHF to the deployment of these awareness campaigns.*








Awareness-raising talk on the preservation of the Amazon rainforest

As part of an international campaign to **protect the Amazon** and in partnership with The Rethink hub, we organized an awareness-raising talk in the presence of Chiefs Watatakalu Yawalapiti and Tapi on May 24, 2023. Around sixty people attended.

Ocean pollution awareness event

On October 5th, we organized an event attended by 120 people to celebrate the premiere of the film BAKELITE, supported by Equestrio Foundation and produced by "On est Prêt", as part of a campaign to mobilize citizens against plastic pollution in our oceans. The event was also an opportunity to celebrate the inauguration of Equestrio Farm and strengthen our ties with potential donors.





Located in the heart of the Jura, the Centre Athénas stands as a **reference in the field of wildlife rescue**. The centre's teams, supported by a network of trans-regional volunteers, **collect and care for injured wild animals** before setting them free in their natural environment. The centre also carries out numerous **awareness-raising operations** to alert as many people as possible to the importance of respecting and saving biodiversity. The Centre Athénas is also the only structure in France **specializing in the care of felids**.

Support from Equestrio Foundation


After two years of partnership, Equestrio Foundation has financed a third and final project for the Centre Athénas.

The center has been welcoming an increasing number of birds since its creation, thereby requiring the creation of new infrastructures. Our funding was used to build a **block** of eight new 15m² aviaries, including monospecific shelters to separate species unable to cohabit due to their predator/prey relationship, and to isolate individuals affected by disease.

The new aviaries will also make it easier to care for the growing number of seizure birds housed at the center.

Reforest to promote biodiversity

For more than 10 years, the association Plantons Utile has been supporting initiatives that contribute to the **ecological transition**, **sustainable development and energy efficiency**. It is particularly active in Africa.

In 2017, Plantons Utile launched a **project for an agro-ecological farm in Casamance** (Senegal). This farm has been designed as a production site following a permaculture model, but also as a place of sharing and training aimed at developing the autonomy and food self-sufficiency of local populations. A reforestation campaign was carried out as part of the project in 2020 and 50 000 trees were planted to improve biodiversity, soil fertility and to limit its erosion. The association led a similar campaign in 2021.

Support from Equestrio Foundation

After the first two years of funding, dedicated in particular to reforestation, agroecology training and various facilities essential to the farm's activities, we renewed our support to Plantons Utile in 2023. Our donation has helped finance, among other things, an existing local initiative led by the Kalissaye Ornithological Reserve to **protect sea** turtles. Our financing has contributed to the protection of more than 1,000 turtle eggs by supplying over ten gabions to the reserve, used to protect nests from predators.

Our funding has also been used towards the reforestation of 300 000m² of mangroves thanks to the planting of 150 000 trees in the Thiobon, Diouloulou and Abéné marine protected areas.

Following our trip in the field to Casamance, we decided to **pursue our support to Plantons Utile** to help them perpetuate their precious impact both on the environment and the local population.

Using humour to warn about lake Geneva's fragility

«To know the lake better is to protect it» - a motto at the heart of the Association pour la Sauvegarde du Léman (ASL). The aims of this association are to preserve the ecological state of the lake through concrete actions in the field, to gain the support of politicians and to set up awareness campaigns.

Support from Equestrio Foundation

To alert the general public, and young people in particular, to the issues involved in preserving water and ecosystems, ASL has launched a **series of 10 videos**, in collaboration with the Swiss humorist Thibaud Agoston. For the past three years, Equestrio Foundation has been working alongside the association to finance this initiative. 2023 marks our final year of collaboration.

Based on the monitoring of the first clips, it has been decided to move towards shorter formats for more reach. In 2023, we therefore financed the creation of eight one-minute capsules, each dealing with a specific theme, that will be issued over 2023 and 2024.

Protecting bees and raising awareness among younger generations

The Geneva-based association APIDAE, composed of beekeepers and nature lovers, was created in 2013 with the goal of raising **awareness about the decline**of biodiversity by using the bee as the emblem of all the damages imposed on nature by humans. Its action is concrete, local and accessible to all.


Support from Equestrio Foundation

In 2021, we financed the entire **«Today we sow»** project, which aims to **distribute** cards filled with melliferous plant seeds to Geneva pupils in order to raise their awareness of the importance of bees in our ecosystems. In 2022, our funding focused on a project which promoted inclusion through beekeeping by training migrants as beekeepers.

For our third and final year of collaboration, we **renewed our support for the «Today we sow» operation**, which also included **three awareness-raising sessions** for teachers on the challenges of declining biodiversity, via the Geneva Department of Public Education (DIP).

The 2023 edition was a true success, with a **15% increase in participation**. A total of 25 schools, 51 classes and almost 2,000 pupils were reached on this key issue for the future of our ecosystems.

You Care Protecting abused animals

Created in 2020, the association YouCare protects animals and biodiversity throughout the world. YouCare is a particularly visionary and innovative association in the field of animal shelters. The association can rely on a solid network in the Paris region and great visibility on social networks. Not only do they manage to find foster families for the animals in their care, but also to secure adoption for most of them.

Support from Equestrio Foundation


Equestrio Foundation supported YouCare for the first year on Reunion Island as part of its «Nouvelle Vie» program, which aims to save as many abandoned animals as possible from euthanasia by helping them find foster homes.

In 2023, our support focused on saving mistreated and abandoned pets in France. YouCare has decided to take action against these widespread injustices by seizing animals from their abusers, in close collaboration with the relevant authorities. The association then places the animals with a foster family, until they are adopted.

Our donation in 2023 contributed to the financing of the veterinary care and legal costs incurred by these seizures. The average cost of seizure amounting to around €400 per animal, our support will have allowed around 25 animals to be saved.

Odyssée des lacs

Swimming to preserve the purity of switzerland's lakes

Noam Yaron is a committed Swiss sportsman who takes on numerous eco-sport challenges. He braves lakes and mountains with a twofold objective: to stretch beyond his limits in new adventures, while at the same time **raising public awareness of the urgency to preserve our environment**, and in particular **Swiss waters**, threatened by the scourge of plastic and chemical pollution.


In 2022, Equestrio Foundation supported Noam's epic «Lake Odyssey» that consisted in swimming across the five largest Swiss lakes in record time, while raising awareness of the importance of preserving this natural heritage. The same year, we also took part in the **Water Lover Challenge**, which saw almost 225,000 cigarette butts collected in 15 days.

At the end of summer 2023, Noam Yaron set himself a new challenge: to cross Switzerland from east to west via the Alps, 100% by human power, i.e. by bike, on foot and by swimming. This **extraordinary ecological adventure in favor of water conservation** also served the practical purpose of sampling the water in Switzerland's mountain lakes. Following this challenge, a new cigarette-butt collection operation was organized, bringing together 554 participants, across eight cantons to collect over 150,000 cigarette butts in 10 days.

Equestrio Foundation financed the project and took part in a collection session which enabled 20,000 cigarette butts to be collected in 1 hour on the streets of Geneva.

Sauvetage de faons

Using technology to protect fawns from the danger of hay cutting

Every year in Switzerland, several thousand fawns are killed during springtime hay cutting. When in danger, a fawn's natural instinct is to take cover in the tall grass and to remain static. This method of defense can unfortunately be the cause of its death as it makes it impossible for the farmers on their tractors to identify the animal nesting.

The association Sauvetage de Faons Jura-Bernois was created in 2019 to avoid this. Thanks to the commitment of its volunteers, it offers farmers a **free service using thermal drones to quickly and safely identify the presence of fawns** in meadows before the mowing starts.


Support from Equestrio Foundation

Equestrio Foundation decided to support these rescue operations for the first year with the **purchase of a drone**, which was used for the start of the 2023 mowing season. This new equipment has enabled the association to **monitor a greater number of plots** following the growing number of farmers wishing to use its services.

Since its creation, the association has rescued 762 fawns, including 344 in 2023.

Crédi ONG-Bénin

Saving red-bellied monkeys



The Regional Center for Education and Research for Integrated Development's (CREDI ONG) aims at promoting the shift towards sustainable lifestyles and consumption patterns, and the implementation of these changes at the political level. The NGO has been active in Benin for some twenty years, through various initiatives encouraging sustainable agriculture, environmental protection, community management of natural resources and education for citizens.

Support from Equestrio Foundation

In 2007, CREDI-ONG initiated the creation of **West Africa's first Community Conservation Park** in the Sitatunga Valley, in southern Benin. Through its funding,

Equestrio Foundation supported the «Save the Zinkaka» project in this park, which

aims for the **protection of red-bellied monkeys**, an endemic West African species

threatened with extinction. The goal of the project, which will run on a 3-year period,

is to secure their habitats and ensure specific monitoring of their population.



Clean My Calanques

Cleaning up the "calanques" in Marseille

Clean My Calanques is an association based in Marseille, created in 2017 out of the desire to act at the local level and to create a **genuine mobilization of citizens** to preserve their environment. After more than five years of existence, the association has carried out 141 cleanups around the Marseille coastline and collected more than 65 tons of waste.

Support from Equestrio Foundation

Currently in a phase of growth, Clean My Calanques is **extending its collection activities to certain areas of Marseille** at the request of many «cleaners». The association has set up "green squads" to mobilize local residents in their neighborhood. Since 80% of the macro-waste that ends up in the sea comes from the land, in particular from rainwater runoff, this project is essential for limiting plastic pollution on the beaches of our Mediterranean coastline.

Equestrio Foundation has contributed to the launch of these ecological squads by financing the tools for the "cleaners" (bags, gloves, pliers, etc.), the equipment for the monthly clean-up operations and the charges for the civic service employee dedicated to the coordination of these operations in 2023.

IFAW

Saving animal victims of the earthquake

IFAW (International Fund for Animal Welfare) is a global non-profit association that carries out high-impact actions to help animals and people thrive together. In 2022, the association worked with European authorities to call for the **inclusion of animals** in all emergency plans (preparation, evacuation and sheltering). IFAW has helped over 100,000 animals affected by disasters worldwide.

Support from Equestrio Foundation

While our Foundation's main vocation is to support long-term projects, our human-scale structure also enables us to be highly reactive in the face of emergencies.

Following the earthquake that hit Morocco in September 2023, and that also took a heavy toll on animal victims, we decided to **support animals in distress with** a **donation to IFAW**, which was passed on directly to l'Arche de Noé, a trusted partner based in Morocco.

Our funds were used to **purchase pet food**, which was distributed to families, and **veterinary equipment** to treat injured dogs, cats and equines, as well as those in need of surgery in a clinic.

The year 2023 has been marked by the increase of Equestrio Foundation's presence in the field. This enabled us to considerably strengthen our ties with project leaders, thanks in particular to more than 17 days spent volunteering by their side to help them in their mission and get closer to their daily lives.

These shared moments were filled with emotion, but above all with renewed awareness. Despite many aborted or forgotten battles, there are hundreds, thousands of courageous, committed people fighting for the future — behind-the-scenes heroes with little means but great ambitions, who are totally committed to the cause of nature.

They act out of conviction. A conviction that nevertheless demands considerable personal sacrifices that they embrace fully, driven by stronger, more pressing, and higher stake issues: the safeguarding of our planet. Their unfailing determination, their genuine love of the living world and their natural generosity are a real source of inspiration and optimism for us.

It is the power of these local impetuses, the strength of concrete action and the power of hopes defying despair that we decide to keep in mind from 2023. But also, some major achievements at a more global level, from the agreement to end bottom trawling in marine protected areas by 2030, to the gradual healing

of the ozone layer, the curbing of deforestation in Amazonia, the historic treaty signed by 70 countries on the protection of high seas, or the return of rhinoceroses and humpback whales.

Despites these inroads we do not overlook the disasters, defeats and status quo that, as time passes, transform into criminal resistance to change. 2023 remains one more step into the abyss of climate change and biodiversity collapse. And this reinforces our determination not to give in to despondent determinism and to turn our gaze, as well as our support, towards those who are convinced that all is still possible.



In keeping with our DNA and our strategy, we will remain true to our two strategic pillars - financial support and awareness raising for the causes we support.

More action, more impact

The decline in our biodiversity is accelerating, and now more than ever we need to step up our action for the sake of the environment and animals. Our strategy in 2024 will partly focus on **expanding our sources** of funding for causes where we know we can have an impact, whether directly in the field or by raising awareness of the need to act, both upstream and downstream. Preventing at the source or repairing - each battle is worth the fight.

Our founder **Alicia Heiniger will continue to cover all operating costs**, so that we can dedicate our donations exclusively to the causes we support. But we want to move further, with more projects funded, more synergies and, above all, more impact.
